WAIPUKURAU BOROUGH COUNCIL.

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, the Council of the Borough of Waipukurau, at a meeting of the said Council held at Waipukurau on the 22nd day of February, 1926, hereby resolves as follows:—

HAWKE'S BAY ELECTRIC-POWER BOARD.

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, the Hawke's Bay Electric-power Board hereby resolves as follows:—

That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of three hundred thousand pounds (£300,000), authorized to be raised by the Hawke's Bay Electric-power Board under the above-mentioned Act, for the supply and distribution of electric power to and for the benefit of that part of the Hawke's Bay Electric-power District comprised in the constituent districts of the Hawke's Bay County and Taradale Town District, [the said Hawke's Bay Electric-power Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of sixteen thirty-firsts of a penny in the pound on the rateable value (on the basis of the capital value) of all rateable property in the County of Hawke's Bay and in the Town District of Taradale; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and shall be payable yearly on the first day of March in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of thirty-six and one-half years, or until the loan is fully paid off.
