

Now, therefore, in pursuance and exercise of the power and authority so conferred upon me by section fourteen of the Native Land Amendment Act, 1914, I, General Sir Charles Fergusson, Baronet, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim that the Native land set out in the Schedule hereto has become Crown land.

**SCHEDULE.**

ALL that area of land in the Auckland Land District, being part Section 17D No. 1, Block IX, Te Aroha Survey District, comprising that area of land 1 acre 3 roods 25 perches bounded on the north-west by other part of Section 17D No. 1, on the north-east by Koromiko Street, on the south-east by Brick Street, and on the south-west by Whitaker Street.

Also that area of 2 acres 0 roods 8 perches bounded on the north-west by other part 17D No. 1 aforesaid, on the north-east by Rata Street, on the south-east by Brick Street, and on the south-west by Koromiko Street.

Also that area of 2 roods 39-9 perches bounded on the north-east by Puriri Street, on the south-east by Brick Street, on the south-west by Rata Street, and on the north-west by other part of 17D No. 1 and Emma Street.

Also that area of 1 acre 9-2 perches bounded on the north-east by Kotuku Street, on the south-east by Bridge Street, on the south-west by Koromiko Street, and on the north-west by Burgess Street.

Also that area of 1 acre 7-2 perches bounded on the north-east by Rata Street, on the south-east by Bridge Street, on the south-west by Kotuku Street, and on the north-west by Burgess Street.

Also that area of 1 acre 3 roods 8-6 perches bounded on the north-east by Church Street, on the south-east by Kenrick Street, on the south-west by Whitaker Street, and on the north-west by Bridge Street.
