RESOLUTION INCREASING SPECIAL RATE.—TE WHANGA ROAD LOAN, £300.

IN pursuance and in exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, and of all other powers (if any) it thereunto enabling, the Horowhenua County Council hereby resolves as follows:—

That, for the purpose of providing for the payment of interest and other charges on a loan of three hundred pounds authorized to be raised by the Horowhenua County Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of forming and metalling a portion of the Te Whanga Road, the said Council pursuant to section 22 of the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, hereby increases to three-hundred-and-forty-seven five-hundredths of a penny (347/500ths) in the pound sterling the special rate of five-eighths of a penny (5/8d.) in the pound sterling made and levied by resolution passed by the said Council on the 12th day of July, 1924, on the rateable value (on the basis of the capital value) of all rateable property in the Te Whanga Road Special-rating District, such rate of five-eighths of a penny (5/8d.) in the pound sterling being insufficient to provide for the payment of interest and other charges on such loan; and that such special rate as increased shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable yearly on the 1st day of June in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of thirty-six and a half (36½) years, or until the loan is fully paid off.
