RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, the Papakura Town Board hereby resolves as follows

That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of £4,500, authorized to be raised by the Papakura Town Board under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of footpath-construction and the purchase of roadmaking-machinery, the said Papakura Town Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of one-fifth of a penny in the punnd upon the rateable value of all rateable property in the Papakura Town District; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable half-yearly on the 30th day of April and the 31st day of October in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of 36½ years, or unti the loan is fully paid off.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, the Waipawa Borough Council (the Mayor, Councillors, and Burgesses of the Borough of Waipawa) hereby resolves as
