

NOTICE UNDER THE PUBLIC WORKS ACT, 1908.

NOTICE is hereby given that the EDUCATION BOARD OF THE DISTRICT OF HAWKE'S BAY intends to execute a certain public work as hereinafter mentioned and to take under the provisions of the Public Works Act, 1908, for the use, convenience, and enjoyment of a public school, and for an extension to the site of a public school, the following lands, namely:—

(a.) All that parcel of land situate in the Borough of Gisborne, containing by admeasurement one rood eight perches and fourteen one-hundredths of a perch (0a. 1r. 08.14p.), more or less, being part of Allotment 25A, Town of Gisborne, being all the land comprised in certificate of title, Volume 42, folio 191, Gisborne Registry, and being the whole of the land edged pink on the plan hereinafter referred to, a copy of which is also deposited in the office of the Department of Lands and Survey at Gisborne under Number 1254 (brown).

(b.) All that parcel of land situate in the Borough of Gisborne containing three roods and four-tenths of a perch (0a. 3r. 0.4p.), more or less, being part of Allotment 25A, Town of Gisborne, being part of the land comprised in certificate of title, Volume 9, folio 83, Gisborne Registry, and being all the land edged blue on the said plan.

Notice is further given that a plan of the lands so required to be taken is deposited in the office of Messieurs Ball and Crawshaw, Land Agents, Peel Street, Gisborne, and is open for inspection by all persons during ordinary office hours.
