ORDER IN COUNCIL.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by the Public Works Act, 1908, and of all other powers in anywise enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby approve of the following resolution passed by the New Plymouth Borough Council on the nineteenth day of October, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-five, viz:—

"That the New Plymouth Borough Council, being the local authority having control of the street hereinafter mentioned, hereby resolves and declares that the provisions of section one hundred and seventeen, subsection one, of the Public Works Act, 1908, shall not apply (a) to that portion of the northern side of Walsh Road to which Subdivision 8 of Section 26, Westown, Fitzroy District, New Plymouth, has frontage, nor (b) to that portion of the western side of Omata Road to which Subdivision 8 of Section 26, Westown, Fitzroy District, has frontage"; subject to the condition that no building or part of a building shall at any time be erected on the land fronting the northern side of the portion of Walsh Road or the western side of the portion of Omata Road (described in the Schedule hereto), within a distance of thirty-three feet from the centre-line of the said portions of streets.

SCHEDULE.

THE northern side of all that portion of street, situated in the Taranaki Land District, Borough of New Plymouth, known as Walsh Road, adjoining Subdivision 8 of Section 26, Westown, Fitzroy District.

Also the western side of all that portion of street, situated in the said land district and borough, known as Omata Road, adjoining Subdivision 8 of Section 26, Westown, Fitzroy District.

As the said portions of streets are more particularly delineated on the plan marked P.W.D. 64824, deposited in the office of the Minister of Public Works at Wellington, in the Wellington Land District, and thereon coloured red.
