Full details of these fog-signals will be found in the List of Lights and List of Wireless Signals, respectively; new informa-tion will continue to be promulgated in full in Notices to Mariners for correction of these publications. The notices henceforth will quote the new form of abridged description, which is to be used for the correction of the charts affected. The signals above mentioned are those which are sounded only dyna, thick of form wrether

only during thick or foggy weather. In the case of buoys fitted with a bell, whistle, &c., which are not given in the List of Lights, details will continue to be shown on the charts as necessary.
