IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in him by the Public Works Act, 1908, and of all other powers in anywise enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby order and declare that the portion of main highway described in the Schedule hereto shall, on and after the date of the gazetting of this Order in Council, become a Government road.

SCHEDULE.

STRATFORD-Taumarunui: All that portion of the main highway known as the Stratford-Taumarunui Main Highway, commencing at the Motutara Stream Bridge, and proceeding thence generally in a north-easterly direction, and terminating at the boundary of the Borough of Taumarunui at the Ongarue River Bridge, passing through the County of Taumarunui; being a distance of 7 miles 60 chains, more or less. As the same is more particularly delineated on the plan marked M.H. 55, deposited in the office of the Minister of Public Works at Wellington, in the Wellington Land District, and thereon coloured blue and marked O-P.
