A PROCLAMATION.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Amendment Act, 1909, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, General Sir Charles Fergusson, Baronet, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby revoke so much of the Proclamation dated the second day of July, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-five, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* No. 51, of the ninth day of July, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-five, taking land for a further portion of the East Coast Main Trunk Railway (Napier Northwards), portions of Putorino and Mohaka Sections, and for road-diversions in connection therewith and a road approach thereto, as affects the land described in the Schedule hereto, such land having been incorrectly described.
