IN pursuance of the powers vested in him by section one hundred and thirty-two of the Municipal Corporations Act, 1920, and of every other power and authority enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby direct that the Wanganui City Council shall defray all the costs of the Commission appointed under the said Act by a Warrant under the hand of His Excellency the Governor-General dated the twenty-third day of February, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-six, to inquire and report upon the proposal contained in the petition of J. R. Gibson and others to exclude a certain area from the City of Wanganui and to include such area in the County of Waitotara.
