PIAKO COUNTY COUNCIL.

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, the Piako County Council hereby resolves as follows:—

That, for the purpose of providing the instalments in respect of the principal, interest, and other charges on a loan of £1,450, authorized to be raised by the Piako County Council under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of metalling the Tahuna Road from the centre of Irwin's Hill to Horrell's Bridge, the said Piako County Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of one penny and one-eighth of a penny ($1\frac{1}{8}$ d.) in the pound on the rateable value (upon the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property in the Irwin's Hill to Horrell's Bridge Special-rating Area, comprising all that area in the Land District of Auckland, being bounded as follows:—

Commencing at a point being the north-west corner of Te Mimi (D.P. 2703), Block I, Maungakawa Survey District, thence following the northern boundary of Te Mimi Block to its north-east corner; thence in a southerly direction following the eastern boundary of Block Te Mimi to the north-east corner of Section 17, Motumaoho No. 2, Block II, Maungakawa Survey District; thence in a westerly direction for a distance of about 25 chains following the northern boundary of the said Section 17; thence in a southerly direction running parallel to the public road through Sections 17 and 18 of Motumaoho No. 2 to the southern boundary of Section 18; thence in a westerly direction following the southern boundaries of Sections 18 and 4, Motumaoho No. 2, for a distance of about 30 chains, to a point at the southern boundary of Section 4; thence in a northerly direction through Sections 4 and 3, Motumaoho No. 2, to a point on the southern boundary of Section 2, being about 15 chains from a public road; thence in a westerly direction for a distance of about 20 chains; thence in a northerly direction, following a line running parallel to a public road, for a distance of about 65 chains; thence in a westerly direction to the western boundary of Te Mimi (D.P. 2703); thence in a northerly direction to the point of commencement:

TARANAKI ELECTRIC-POWER BOARD.

RESOLUTION STRIKING SPECIAL RATE.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, the Taranaki Electric-power Board at a meeting of the said

Board held at Eltham on the 19th day of July, 1926, hereby resolves as follows:—

That for the purpose of providing the interest, sinking fund, and other charges on a loan of £75,000, authorized to be raised by the said Board under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of completing the undertaking authorized by the poll of the ratepayers of the Taranaki Electric-power District taken on the 5th day of July, 1926, the said Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of 27/100ths of 1d. in the pound on the rateable value (on the basis of capital value) of all rateable property in the Taranaki Electric-power District (and which district is more fully described in the Third Schedule to the *New Zealand Gazette* supplement of 18th May, 1922, No. 40, page 1374); and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the said loan, and be payable yearly on the first day of October in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of 36½ years, or until the said loan is fully paid off.

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, and the Local Authority Empowering (Relief of Unemployment) Act, 1926, the Palmerston North Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:—

That for the purpose of providing the interest and sinking fund and other charges on a loan of £6,000, known as the Palmerston North Public Works (Relief of Unemployment) Loan, 1926, of £6,000, authorized to be raised by the Palmerston North Borough Council under the above-mentioned Acts for the purpose of regrading and improving the streets in the Borough of Palmerston North and forming and constructing a roadway connecting with Fitzherbert Street in the Borough Reserve, being Section 1536, Palmerston North, the said Palmerston North Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of one-nineteenth of a penny in the pound upon the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property of the Borough of Palmerston North, comprising the whole of the Borough of Palmerston North; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable yearly on the 1st day of July in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty years—that is to say, until the 31st day of July, 1946, or until the loan is fully paid off.
