Warrant vesting the Control of the Hoteo River Bridge on the Helensville-Port Albert Road, in the Rodney County Council.

In pursuance and exercise of the power and authority vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1908, and of all other powers and authorities in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, General Sir Charles Fergusson, Baronet, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby direct that the bridge over the Hoteo River on the Helensville - Port Albert Road (as more particularly described in the Schedule hereto) shall, on and after the date of the gazetting hereof, be under the exclusive care, control, and management of the Rodney County Council.

That bridge in the North Auckland Land District over the Hoteo River on the Helensville – Port Albert Road, known as the Hoteo River bridge, situated near the northernmost corner of Section 3, Block X, Tauhoa Survey District.
