Pleasant (Nauru) Island.—Information re Position.

Position.—W/T mast, lat. 0° 32' 00" S., long. 166° 55' 00" E. (approx.).

Details.—Pleasant Island is situated further southward than charted.

The above position, which is the mean of the observations obtained by H.M.S. "Dart" and S.S. "Nauru Chief," is to be substituted for that of No. 1 jetty in the title of the plan. The plan is to be re-graduated accordingly.
