N pursuance of the powers and authorities conferred upon him by the Animals Bartage and authorities conferred upon him by the Animals Protection and Game Act, 1921-22 (hereinafter referred to as "the said Act"), and of all other powers and authorities enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby make the following amending regulations by way of amendment to the Opossum Regulations, 1926 (hereinafter called the principal regulations").

# REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Opossum Regu-1. These regulations may be cred as the opossum regulations Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and form part of the Opossum Regulations, 1926.

2. On payment of any royalty by a licensed broker there shall be allowed to such broker a commission of 5 per centum.

3. Such commission shall be payable when such broker shall have forwarded the monthly return referred to in clause (2) of Regulation 7 of the principal regulations, and shall be allowed in respect of all royalties paid by such broker the particulars of payment of which shall at the time of payment of the commission have been forwarded to the Under-Secretary as provided by clause (13) of Regulation 8 of the principal regulations.
