IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred on him by the Census and Statistics Act, 1910, and by the Dairy-produce Export Control Act, 1923, and in pursuance and exercise of every other power enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby make the regulations hereinafter set forth, and declare that the said regulations shall take effect on the day of the publication thereof in the *Gazette*.

REGULATIONS.

1. To enable the Statistician to compile statistics of dairy-produce according to districts of production and to give the certificate required under subsection (2) of section 7 of the Dairy-produce Export Control Amendment Act, 1926, the Statistician shall, in addition to the matters specified in paragraphs (a) to (j) of section 21 of the Census and Statistics Act,
