*Notice respecting Proposed Alteration of Boundaries of the Borough of South Invercargill.*

IT is hereby notified that a petition has been presented to His Excellency the Governor-General, under the Municipal Corporations Act, 1920, praying that the area described in the Schedule hereto may be excluded from the Borough of South Invercargill and included in the County of Southland. SCHEDULE.

AREA PROPOSED TO BE EXCLUDED FROM THE BOROUGH OF SOUTH INVERCARGILL.

"A."

ALL that area in the Southland Land District bounded by a line commencing at the point where Kingswell Creek crosses

the borough boundary; thence along the south-eastern bank of that creek to the northern side of Ball Street; thence easterly along the said northern side of Ball Street to a point in line with the western boundary of Section 66, Block I, Township of Seaward Bush; thence to and along that boundary and the western boundary of Section 38, Block I aforesaid, to the southern side of McQuarry Street; thence along the southern side of McQuarry Street to a point in line with the western boundary of Section 20, Block I aforesaid; thence northerly along the western boundary of Section 20 and the southern and western boundaries of Section 10, Block I aforesaid, to the southern side of Tramway Road; thence a right line across Tramway Road to the western boundary of Lot 12, Section 33, Block XIX, Invercargill Hundred; thence along the western boundaries of Lots 12, 13, 14, 15, and 16, Section 33 aforesaid, to John Street; thence along the southern side of John Street to the borough boundary; thence bounded on the east, south, and south-west by the borough boundary to Kingswell Creek, the place of commencement.

*Open Season for Deer-shooting—Wanganui Acclimatization District.*

IN exercise of the powers vested in me by the Animals Protection and Game Act, 1921-22, I, Richard Francis Bollard, Minister of Internal Affairs of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby declare the period from the 1st day of April, 1926, to the 15th day of May, 1926 (both days inclusive), to be an open season in the Wanganui Acclimatization District, described in the First Schedule hereto, for the taking or killing of the following imported game—viz., fallow-deer bucks and does—subject to the following conditions.

CONDITIONS.

1. LICENSEES to take or kill fallow-deer bucks and does may be issued by the Chief Postmaster at Wanganui, on payment of a license fee of £1, in the form prescribed in the Second Schedule hereto, and subject to the said Act and regulations thereunder and this notification. The number of such licenses to be issued by the said Chief Postmaster shall not exceed forty. Provided that not more than one such license shall be issued to the same person.
2. No licensee shall take or kill more than two bucks and three does, and no buck shall be killed carrying antlers with less than twelve points. Ball cartridge only to be used; provided that no metal-patched or metal-cased bullet shall be used for killing such deer.
3. No licensee shall allow any dog to accompany either himself or any attendant he may have with him.
4. Nothing herein contained shall extend to authorizing any person to sell any deer or portion thereof.
5. Nothing in any license to take or kill fallow-deer bucks and does shall authorize the holder thereof to take or kill fallow-deer bucks or does on lands actually and exclusively used by any registered acclimatization society for acclimatization purposes, or on any sanctuary or public domain, or on any land excepted from the operation of the notification declaring an open season for the district.
6. The licensee must give notice to the said Chief Postmaster of the date on which it is his intention to stalk deer, such notice to be posted or delivered or telegraphed three clear days before such date.
7. Any person committing a breach of any of these conditions is liable, on conviction, to a fine of £20.
