RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

IN pursuance and in exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, and of all other powers (if any) it thereunto enabling, the Waipukurau Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:—

That, for the purpose of providing for the payment of interest, sinking fund, and other charges on the Waipukurau Borough Unemployment Relief Loan of £500, 1927, authorized to be raised by the Waipukurau Borough Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of Reservoir Road Extension, the said Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of sixty-three one-thousandths (63/1,000ths) of a penny in the pound sterling on the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property in the whole of the Borough of Waipukurau, and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable yearly on the 1st day of August in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of ten (10) years, or until the loan is fully paid off.

RESOLUTIONS MAKING SPECIAL RATES.

Loan of £1,600.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Waipa County Council hereby resolves as follows:—

That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of £1,600, authorized to be raised by the Waipa County Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of forming, culverting, and metalling for the first time roads in the Puahue Special-rating Area, the said Waipa County Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of three-eighths of a penny (¾d.) in the pound upon the rateable (capital) value of all rateable properties in the Puahue Special-rating Area, comprising all that area in the County of Waipa bounded by a line commencing at the north-western corner of Puahue 1E Block, south-easterly by the north-eastern boundaries of Sections 1s, 2s, 4s, and 5s of the Puahue Settlement to the northern corner of Section 10s, Puahue Settlement; thence by the northern and eastern boundaries of the said Section 10s to the south-eastern corner of that section; thence by the eastern boundary of Section 16s, Puahue Settlement, and Maungatautari 4E 4, 4E 5, 4E 2, and 4E 3 Blocks to the south-eastern corner of the said 4E 3 Block; thence north-westerly by the north bank of the Mangahoe Stream to the point where it crosses the Confiscated Boundary-line at the south-western corner of
