HAMILTON BOROUGH COUNCIL.

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Hamilton Borough Council hereby resolves:—

That, for the purpose of providing the interest and sinking fund on a loan of £16,000, authorized to be raised by the Hamilton Borough Council under the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, and section 24 of the Health Act, 1920, to be expended in the work of providing a piped drain to carry to the Waikato River effluents at present being discharged in the Waitawhiriwhiri Stream by the septic tanks of the Hamilton Borough Council, including the cost of all necessary labour, materials, plant, tools, engineer's fees, supervision, plans, and compensation to owners of property, the said Hamilton Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of one-fifth (1/5th) of a penny in the pound on the rateable value (unimproved) of all rateable property in the Borough of Hamilton, and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable on the first day of April in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period not exceeding 36½ years or until the loan is fully paid off.

MASTERTON COUNTY COUNCIL.

RESOLUTION STRIKING SPECIAL RATE.

IN pursuance and in exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, and of all other powers (if any) it thereunto enabling, the Masterton County Council hereby resolves as follows:—

That, for the purpose of providing for the payment of interest, sinking fund, and other charges on the Masterton County Stronvar-Ngahape Special-rating District Loan of £1,500, 1927, authorized to be raised by the Masterton County Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of metalling approximately two miles and a half of the Stronvar Road and approximately three-quarters of a mile of the Ngahape Road in the Wainuioru Riding, the said Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of thirteen-thirty-seconds (13/32nds) of a penny in the pound sterling on the rateable value (on the basis of the capital value) of all rateable property in the Stronvar-Ngahape Special-rating District, being more particularly described in the Schedule at the foot hereof, and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable yearly on the first day of August in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of thirty-six and one-half (36½) years, or until the loan is fully paid off.

SCHEDULE.

Commencing at the south-westernmost corner of Section 1, Block I, Kaiwhata Survey District, and its junction with the Kaiwhata River; thence in a southerly direction along the eastern boundary of the said river to the south-westernmost corner of Section 12, Block I, Kaiwhata Survey District; thence along the southern boundary of the said Section 12 to the south-easternmost corner of Section 11, Block IV, Kaiwhata Survey District; thence in a northerly direction along the eastern boundary of the said Section 11 to the southern boundary of Subdivision 2 of Section 7c No. 3, Te Maipi, Block IV, Kaiwhata Survey District; thence in an easterly and northerly direction along the southern and eastern boundaries of the said Subdivision No. 2 to the south-easternmost corner of Section 7c No. 6, Te Maipi, Blocks I and II, Kaiwhata Survey District; thence along the eastern boundary of the said Section 7c No. 6 to the north-easternmost corner of the same section; thence in a westerly direction along the northern boundary of the said Section 7c No. 6 to the south-easternmost corner of Section 6B, Te Maipi, Blocks I and II, Kaiwhata Survey District; thence in a northerly direction along the eastern boundary of the said Section 6B to its junction with the Kaiwhata River; thence along the western boundary of the said river to the southern boundary of Section 1, Block II, Kaiwhata Survey District; thence in a south-easterly direction to the south-easternmost corner of the said Section 1; thence in a northerly direction along the eastern boundary of the said Section 1, Blocks II, Kaiwhata, and XIV, Rewa, and Section 3, Block XIV, Rewa, to the south-eastern corner of part of Section 896, Block XIV, Rewa Survey District; thence in an easterly direction along the southern boundary of the said part of Section 896 to the south-westernmost corner of part of Section 897; thence along the southern and eastern boundaries of the said section to the north-easternmost corner of the same section; thence along the northern boundaries of the said part of Sections 897 and 896 to the eastern boundary of Run 52, Block XIV, Rewa; thence in a northerly, north-westerly, north-easterly, and easterly direction, to the south-western boundary of part of Section 885, Block XIV, Rewa Survey District; thence along the southern boundary of the said part of Section 885 and part Section 886, Block XIV, Rewa Survey District, to the south-easternmost corner of the said Section 886; thence along the eastern boundary of the said part Section 886 to the north-easternmost corner of the same section; thence along the northern boundaries of the said part Sections 886 and 885 to the north-easternmost corner of Run 52, Block X, Rewa Survey District; thence along the northern and western boundaries of the said Run 52 to the north-easternmost boundary of Section 53, Block XIV, Rewa Survey District; thence in a westerly direction along the northern and western boundaries of the said Section 53 to the north-easternmost corner of Section 54, Block XIV, Rewa Survey District; thence in a westerly and south-westerly direction along the northern boundary of the said Section 53 to the junction of part of Section 80, Block IX, Rewa Survey District, with the western boundary of the Stronvar Road; thence in a westerly direction along the Stronvar Road to its junction with Armstrong's Road and part of Section 79, Block IX, Rewa Survey District; thence along the eastern boundary of Armstrong's Road to the southern boundary of the said Section 79; thence in an easterly direction along the southern boundaries of Sections 79 and 80 to the western boundary of Section 54, Block XIII, Rewa Survey District; thence in a southerly direction along the western boundary of the said Section 54 and Lots 5, 4, 3, 2, and 1, Ngahape Settlement, to the south-western boundary of the said Lot 1; thence along the western and southern boundary of part of Section 2, Te Maipi, Block I, Kaiwhata Survey District, to the Kaiwhata River; thence in a southerly direction along the western boundary of the Kaiwhata River to the point of commencement.
