Regulations under the State Advances Act, 1913, and its Amendments

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

N pursuance and exercise of the powers and authority L conferred upon him by the State Advances Act, 1913, the Rural Advances Act, 1926, and of all other powers and authorities in that behalf enabling him, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby make the additional regulations hereinafter set forth; and doth declare that these additional regulations shall come into force on the date of the publication thereof in the New Zealand Gazette.

REGULATIONS.

EVERY application for an advance under the Rural Advances Branch shall be in the form set out in the First Schedule hereto, or to the effect thereof.

The arount of the valuation fee payable in respect of an application for an advance under the Rural Advances Branch shall be in accordance with the following scale :---
