ALL that area in the Wellington Land District bounded by a line commencing at a point in the middle of the Waitohu Stream in line with the eastern boundary of Lot 3 on plan 3364, deposited in the office of the District Land Registrar at Wellington; thence along the middle of the Waitohu Stream to the eastern side of the Old Coach Road; thence southerly along the eastern side of the Old Coach Road to the westernmost corner of Pukekaraka No. 5; thence across that road and southerly along its western side to the north-eastern corner of Pirihaha No. 3 Block; thence along the northern and western boundaries of Pirihaha No. 3 to the northern boundary of Pirihaha No. 4 and along the northern boundary of Pirihaha No. 4 to the eastern boundary of Lot 4 on plan 3364 aforesaid; thence northerly along the eastern boundaries of Lots 4 and 3 aforesaid, and that boundary produced to the middle of the Waitohu Stream, the point of commencement.

Also all that area in the Wellington Land District bounded by a line commencing at the confluence of the Maringiwai Stream and the Maungapiharau Creek; thence up the Maungapiharau Creek to its intersection with the western boundary of Maungapiharau Block; thence along that boundary to the south-western corner of the said block; thence westerly along the southern boundary of the Takapu Block to its south-western corner; thence along the western boundary of the said Takapu Block to and across a public road, and thence along the northern side of that road to its intersection with the Rangioru Creek; thence along the eastern bank of that creek to a point in line with the south-western boundary of Lot 5 on plan 3364, deposited in the office of the District Land Registrar at Wellington; thence to and along the southern boundaries of Lots 5, 6, and 8, on plan 3364 aforesaid to the place of commencement.
