Change of Name of Locality "Maxwelltown" to "Maxwell."

W HEREAS settlers in the locality known as "Maxwelltown," in the County of Waitotara, desire that the name of such locality should be changed to "Maxwell," and it is considered expedient to alter the same :

it is considered expedient to alter the same : Now, therefore, I, General Sir Charles Fergusson, Baronet, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred on me by the Designation of Districts Act, 1908, and of all other powers and authorities enabling me in this behalf, do hereby proclaim and declare that the name of the locality known as "Maxwelltown," in the County of Waitotara, shall be and the same is hereby altered to "Maxwell," and do assign the lastmentioned name to such locality accordingly ; and also do hereby proclaim and declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on the first day of August, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-seven, not being earlier than six months after the first publication thereof in the *Gazette*.
