RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

TN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Council of the County of Hauraki Plains doth hereby resolve as follows :

follows:— That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of £5,000, authorized to be raised by this Council under the above Act, and known as "The Kerepeehi Riding Roads Loan," the said Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of one penny half-penny ($1\frac{1}{2}d$.) in the pound sterling on the rateable value (on the basis of the un-pennet). improved value) of all rateable property in the Kerepechi
