Additions to Regulations under the Plumbers Registration Act, 1912.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House, at Wellington, this 8th day of August, 1927.

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred on him by section sixteen of the Plumbers Registration Act, 1912 (hereinafter referred to as "the said Act"), His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby declare that in the districts or localities set out in the Schedule hereto, after six months from the date of the coming into force of this regulation, all sanitary plumbing shall be done by a person registered under the said Act; and doth further declare that the regulation hereby made shall form part of and be read with the regulations made under the said Act on the eighteenth day of May, one thousand nine hundred and fourteen, and gazetted on the twenty-first day of May then instant, and shall come into force on the first day of September, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-seven.

- (5) Waitotara County: All that area outside the City of Wanganui within a radius of ten miles of the boundary of the City of Wanganui.
- (6) Wanganui County: All that area outside the City of Wanganui within a radius of ten miles of the boundary of Wanganui City.
- (7) Waitemata County: That portion of the Waitemata County known as the ridings of Birkenhead, Takapuna, and Wainui.
