HUNTLY TOWN BOARD.**RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.**

THAT, for the purpose of providing the instalments in respect of principal and interest and also the other charges on a loan of £1,200 (being 10 per cent. on the original loan of £12,000), authorized to be raised by the Huntly Town Board under the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, for the purpose of defraying the cost of erecting municipal buildings, including the purchase of the necessary site, and the provision of a public hall, with library, ladies' rest-room, Plunket nurse-room, municipal offices, and necessary furniture throughout, the said Huntly Town Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of 11/40ths (eleven fortieths of one penny) in the pound on the rateable value of all rateable property of the Huntly Town District, comprising the whole of the Huntly Town District; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable half-yearly on the 1st day of April and the 1st day of October in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of 36½ years, or until the loan is fully paid off.
