thence along the western and southern boundaries of said section and the southern and eastern boundaries of No. 16J to its intersection with the boundary between parts Rangiuru No. 2A No. 1, and No. 2A No. 2; thence eastwards along this boundary and its prolongation across the public road to its intersection with the western boundary of Rangiuru No. 2A No. 3; thence northwards, eastwards, and southwards, and westwards along the boundaries of No. 2A No. 3 to its intersection with the boundary between the public road and part Rangiuru No. 2A No. 2; thence southwards and eastwards along the boundaries of No. 2A No. 2 and along the prolongation of its southern boundary to its intersection with the right bank of the Kaituna River; thence along this bank of the river to its intersection with the north boundary of Paengaroa North D No. 1A; thence eastwards along this boundary and the boundary of Paengaroa North D No. 1F, to its intersection with the western boundary of B No. 1D; thence along the western boundaries of B No. 1D, B No. 1G, and B No. 1F, No. 2 and along the northern boundary of B No. 1F No. 2 to its intersection with the southern boundary of Main Highway No. 15; thence westwards along this highway boundary to its intersection with the boundary between Pukaingataru B No. 5B and B No. 4; thence northwards across Main Highway No. 15 and the East Coast Main Trunk Railway to the south-east corner of Pukaingataru B No. 8; thence northwards along the eastern boundary of B No. 8 to its intersection with the prolongation westwards across the public road of the northern boundary of Pukaingataru B No. 7A; thence eastwards along this prolongation and the northern boundary of B No. 7A to the boundary of B No. 9; thence southwards, eastwards, and northwards, around the boundaries of B No. 9, and eastwards along the northern boundary of Pukaingataru B No. 10, section 2, and its prolongation eastwards across the public road to its intersection with the western boundary of Pukaingataru B No. 11; thence northwards and eastwards along the boundaries of B No. 11 and eastwards and southwards along the boundaries of B No. 22 to the intersection of its eastern boundary with the northern boundary of the public road; thence eastwards along this road boundary, and its prolongation eastwards to its intersection with the western boundary of Paengaroa North 1B, in Block IV, Maketu Survey District; thence southwards and eastwards along the boundaries of 1B to the intersection of its southern boundary with the western boundary of the public road; thence northwards along this road boundary to the north-east corner of Rau-o-te-Huia B No. 2A; thence westwards along the northern boundary of B No. 2A, and northwards and eastwards along the boundaries of Rau-o-te-Huia B No. 1B to the south-east corner of Waitepuia No. 4A; thence northwards along the eastern boundaries of Waitepuia No. 4A and 4B to its intersection with the southern boundary of Wharekahu; thence westwards, northwards, and eastwards around the boundaries of Wharekahu; thence northwards and westwards along the northern boundary of Whakapoukorero No. 1, across the public road to the intersection of this boundary with the right bank of the Kaituna River in Block IV, Maketu Survey District; thence westwards along the right bank of the Kaituna River to its intersection with the eastern boundary of Tumu Kaituna No. 11A; thence northwards along this eastern boundary prolonged across the River Kaituna to its intersection with the left bank of the Kaituna River; thence northwards and eastwards along this river bank to its intersection with the eastern boundary of Tumu Kaituna No. 11C; thence along this boundary to its intersection with high-water mark, spring tide, of the coast-line; thence westwards along the high-water mark to the north-east corner of Tumu Kaituna No. 11B, Section 2; thence southwards, westwards, and northwards along the boundaries of No. 11B, Section 2, to its north-west corner; thence westwards along the high-water mark, spring tide, of the coast-line to the north-east corner of Tumu Kaituna, No. 6; in Block V, Tumu Survey District; thence southwards and westwards along the boundaries of No. 6, and northwards along the western boundary of Tumu Kaituna No. 8B No. 1, and westwards along the southern boundary of Tumu Kaituna No. 7A to its intersection with the eastern boundary of Tumu Kaituna No. 3; thence northwards along this boundary to its intersection with high-water mark, spring tide, of the coast-line; thence westwards along the coast-line to the point of commencement, being the north-west corner of Section 1, Block IV, Tumu Survey District; the said lands lying within the said special-rating area being situated in Blocks IV, V, and VI, of the Tumu Survey District, and Blocks II, III, and IV, of the Maketu Survey District;

And that such special rates shall be annually recurring rates during the currency of such loan, and be payable yearly on the 15th day of April in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of thirty (30) years, or until the loan is fully paid off.

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

IN pursuance and in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, and all other powers in that behalf the Ellerslie Town Board hereby resolves as follows:—

That, for the purpose of providing the instalments in respect of principal and interest and also the other charges on a loan of £1,000, authorized to be raised by the Ellerslie Town Board under the above-mentioned Acts, for the relief of unemployment, the Ellerslie Town Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of two twenty-fifths of one penny in the pound on the unimproved value of all rateable property in the Town District of Ellerslie, and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable annually on the 30th day of June in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of 36½ years, or until such loan is fully paid off.

RESOLUTIONS MAKING SPECIAL RATES.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Invercargill Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:—

Unemployment Relief Loan (1927) No. 2 of £7,200.

That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of £7,200, authorized to be raised by the Invercargill Borough Council under the Municipal Corporations Act, 1920, and the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, and every other power and authority it thereunto enabling, for the purpose of carrying out certain specified public works for the relief of unemployment within the Borough of Invercargill, the said Invercargill Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of decimal nought nine one of a penny (-091d.) in the pound upon the rateable value of all the rateable property of the Borough of Invercargill, comprising the whole of the Borough of Invercargill, and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable yearly on the 1st day of August in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period as prescribed by the Governor-General by Order in Council, or until the loan is fully paid off.

Supplementary Public Baths Loan of £1,250.

That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of £1,250, authorized to be raised by the Invercargill Borough Council under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of completing the erection of the Public Baths, the said Invercargill Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of decimal nought one six (-016d.) of a penny in the pound upon the rateable value of all the rateable property of the Borough of Invercargill, comprising the whole of the Borough of Invercargill, and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable yearly on the 1st day of August in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period as prescribed by the Governor-General by Order in Council, or until the loan is fully paid off.
