11. No payment on account of the scholarship will be made | until the whole examination is passed.

12. Applications from candidates, accompanied by a fee of £1, and by a certificate from the Director of the school of mines stating the number of lectures which the student has attended in each subject, must reach the Mines Department,

13. Candidates must present themselves for examination on the day fixed, as provided in Regulation No. 7.
14. The Minister of Mines retains to himself the right of cancelling any scholarships should the holder attend irregularly or be reported for idleness or bad conduct.
