### [L.S.] CHARLES FERGUSSON, Governor-General. A PROCLAMATION.

I N pursuance of the power and authority conferred upon me by section four of the Discharged Soldiers Settle-ment Act, 1915, I, General Sir Charles Fergusson, Baronet, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the area of settlement land de scribed in the Schedule hereto shall be, and the same is hereby, set apart and declared open for disposal by way of sale or lease to discharged soldiers, under special tenures, in the manner provided in the said Act.

AUCKLAND LAND DISTRICT.—SETTLEMENT LAND. SECTION 80s, Te Miro Settlement: Area, 2 roods 22 perches.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1908, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, General Sir Charles Fergusson, Baronet, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby

proclaim and declare that the Crown land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby set apart for the purposes of a State Forest, and I also hereby declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the twenty-eighth day of April, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-eight.
