Redefining Boundaries of the Borough of Woodville, the County of Woodville, and the Mangaatua Riding of the County of Woodville.

PURSUANT to the provisions of section 141 of the Municipal Corporations Act, 1920, the boundaries of the Borough of Woodville are hereby defined as set out in the First Schedule hereto, the boundaries of the said borough having been altered by Order in Council dated the 29th day of March, 1928, made under the Municipal Corporations Act, 1920, and published in *Gazette* No. 27, of the 29th day of March, 1928.

And also in pursuance of the provisions of the said section 141 of the Municipal Corporations Act, 1920, the boundaries of the County of Woodville affected by the said Order in Council dated the 29th day of March, 1928, are hereby defined as set out in the Second Schedule hereto.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

BOUNDARIES OF BOROUGH OF WOODVILLE.

ALL that area on the Hawke's Bay Land District bounded by a line commencing at the north-west corner of Rural Section 175; thence easterly along the southern side of Sowry Road to the western side of Pinfold Road; thence southerly along the western side of Pinfold Road to the southern side of Vogel Street; thence easterly along the southern side of Vogel Street to the north-eastern corner of Rural Section 71; thence southerly along the eastern boundary of Section 71 aforesaid to the Mangaatua River; thence down the Mangaatua River to the western boundary of Rural Section 72
