“The Wellington City Council, being the local authority having control of the streets in the City of Wellington, hereby declares that the provisions of section one hundred and seventeen of the Public Works Act, 1908, shall not apply to the western and northern side of that portion of Selwyn Terrace beginning at a point 142.65 links from its junction with Hill Street and extending for a distance of approximately 69.19 and 39.39 links respectively, and also shall not apply to the southern side of same Terrace, beginning at its termination and extending for a distance of approximately 52.78 links, both portions of said Selwyn Terrace fronting parts of Town Section 552, or as more particularly delineated on certificate of title, Deeds Vol. 174, folio 191, in office of District Land Registrar, Wellington” ;

subject to the condition that no building or part of a building shall at any time be erected on the land fronting the western or southern sides of the portions of Selwyn Terrace (described in the Schedule hereto), within a distance of ten feet from the boundaries of the said portions of street.
