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WELLINGTON CITY COUNCIL.

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the provisions of the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, and of all other Acts and powers it in this behalf enabling, the Wellington City Council hereby resolves on the 29th day of June, 1928, as follows:—

That, for the purpose of providing the interest, sinking fund, and other charges on a special loan of ten thousand pounds (£10,000) to be known as “The Wellington City Unemployment Loan, 1928,” authorized to be raised by the Wellington City Council under the above-mentioned Acts for the purpose of carrying out public works for the relief of unemployment, namely—

- The formation of Western Park, Nairnville Park, Kaiwarra Park, and Lyall Bay Reserve;
- Tree-planting on Town Belt;
- The widening and formation of Glenmore Street, Tinakori Road, Salamanca Road, Brooklyn Roads, Chaytor Street, the approaches to the Northland Tunnel, Point Halswell Road, and Wadestown Road;

the said Wellington City Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of one eighty-fourth of a penny (1/84d.) in the pound on the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property in the City of Wellington, and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable yearly on the 1st day of August in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of ten (10) years from the 30th day of June, 1928, or until the loan is fully paid off.
