HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred on me by section twenty-five of the Naval Defence Act, 1913, and of all other powers and authorities enabling me in that behalf, I, General Sir Charles Fergusson, Baronet, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, do hereby amend and supplement the regulations referred to in the Schedule hereto as shown therein.

*Revoking the Naturalization of Edwin Vallentine Holmberg Holmes.*

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS a certificate of naturalization was issued to Edwin Vallentine Holmberg Holmes on the thirtieth day of September, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-six : And whereas the Governor-General in Council is satisfied that it is advisable to revoke the naturalization of the said Edwin Vallentine Holmberg Holmes :

Now, therefore, in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in him by the British Nationality and Status of Aliens (in New Zealand) Act, 1923, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby revoke the said certificate of naturalization, and hereby declare that the naturalization of the said Edwin Vallentine Holmberg Holmes shall be revoked, and that the said Edwin Vallentine Holmberg Holmes shall cease to be a British subject naturalized in New Zealand as on and from the thirtieth day of July, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-eight.
