IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1908, the Public Works Amendment Act, 1923, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, General Sir Charles Fergusson, Baronet, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the middle-line of the road desired to be constructed over Blocks VI and X, Norsewood Survey District—viz., a deviation of the Napier to Wellington (via Wairarapa) Main Highway—shall be that defined and set forth in the Schedule hereto.
