Authorizing the Laying-off of a Road of Less Width than 66 ft.

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the Minister of Lands, it is inexpedient, by reason of the fact that the land shown upon the plan of Town of Three Kings Extension No. 22, Allotments 86, 87, 88, 89, 90, 91, 92, 118, and 119 of Section 10, Suburbs of Auckland, in Block IV, Titirangi Survey District, is intended to be used wholly for residential purposes; that the roads shown therein and named Buller Crescent, Reid Avenue, Whiteby Crescent, Hobbs Avenue, Fletcher Avenue, Windsor Place, and Morley Avenue, respectively, should be of the width of 66 ft.:

Now, therefore, I, Alexander Donald McLeod, Minister of Lands, do hereby, in pursuance of the power conferred upon me by section 17, subsection (1), of the Land Act, 1924, and of every other power me thereunto enabling, authorize the laying-off of such road of a width of 39.6 ft.: Provided always that it shall not be lawful for any person to erect or cause to be erected any building at a less distance than 33 ft. from the middle of such road.
