Revocation of the Reservation of a Permanent State Forest.

A PROCLAMATION.

BY virtue and in exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon me by the Forests Act, 1921-22, and pursuant to a resolution in that behalf passed by both Houses of Parliament, I, General Sir Charles Fergusson, Baronet, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby revoke (so far only as it relates to the Crown land described in the Schedule hereto) the Proclamation of the seventeenth day of November, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-six, whereby the said land (with certain other land) was set apart as a permanent State forest, and declare that the reservation thereby effected is (so far only as aforesaid) revoked accordingly.

SCHEDULE.

AUCKLAND FOREST-CONSERVATION REGION, AUCKLAND LAND DISTRICT.

ALL that area containing by admeasurement 3 acres 2 roods 7 perches, being portion of State Forest No. 33 (*Gazette*, 1886, page 1497), situated in Blocks XV and XVI, Mara-maru Survey District, and being a strip of land one chain wide along the south-eastern boundary of the aforesaid State forest, from the public road to Lake Waikare, a distance of 3538.5 links. As the same is more particularly delineated on plan numbered 25/5, deposited in the Head Office of the State Forest Service, at Wellington, and thereon bordered red.
