A PROCLAMATION.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Land Act, 1924, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, General Sir Charles Fergusson, Baronet, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby amend the Proclamation dated the twelfth day of May, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-eight, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* No. 43 of the seventeenth day of the same month, proclaiming as closed portion of a road in Block I, Otahuhu Survey District, by inserting therein the following Schedule in lieu of the Schedule mentioned therein, which is hereby revoked.
