At the Government House at Wellington, this 17th day of September, 1928.

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

ON the recommendation of the Native Land Purchase Board, referred to in section three hundred and sixty-three of the Native Land Act, 1909, and in exercise of the power in this behalf conferred upon him by that section, and by section one hundred and eleven of the Native Land Amendment Act, 1913 (as amended by section eight of the Native Land Amendment and Native Land Claims Adjustment Act, 1916), His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council thereof, doth hereby extend for a further period of eighteen months the order in Council dated the thirteenth day of April, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-seven, and gazetted the twenty-first day of April, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-seven, but only in so far as it affects the Native lands specified in the Schedule hereto prohibiting all alienation other than alienation in favour of the Crown.

ON the recommendation of the Native Land Purchase Board, referred to in section three hundred and sixty-three of the Native Land Act, 1909, and in exercise of the power in this behalf conferred upon him by that section, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council thereof, doth hereby extend for a further period of six months the Order in Council dated the third day of October, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-seven, and gazetted the sixth day of October, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-seven, prohibiting all alienation of the Native lands specified in the Schedule hereto other than alienation in favour of the Crown.

ON the recommendation of the Native Land Purchase Board, referred to in section three hundred and sixty-three of the Native Land Act, 1909, and in exercise of the power in this behalf conferred upon him by that section, and by section one hundred and eleven of the Native Land Amendment Act, 1913 (as amended by section eight of the Native Land Amendment and Native Land Claims Adjustment Act, 1916), His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council thereof, doth hereby extend for a further period of eighteen months the Order in Council dated the twenty-second day of March, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-seven, and gazetted the seventh day of April, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-seven, prohibiting all alienation of the Native lands specified in the Schedule hereto, other than alienation in favour of the Crown.
