

the northern boundary of Section 44 (Puketotara), Block V, aforesaid; thence up that stream to its intersection with the north-west boundary of Subdivision 6E, Maruata Block; thence north-easterly along the north-western boundary of the said subdivision and its production to the Waitangi Stream; thence down the said Waitangi Stream to the western boundary of Section 1, Blocks V and VI, Whangarei Survey District; thence down that boundary to the northern boundary of Section 43, Parahaki Parish; thence easterly along that boundary to the north-eastern corner of Section 43 aforesaid; thence southerly along the eastern boundaries of Sections 43, 42, and 41 to a closed road; thence south-westerly along that closed road to a public road; thence easterly along that road to the north-eastern corner of Section 30, Parahaki Parish; thence southerly along the eastern boundaries of Sections 30, 29, 28, 27, 87, 10, 9, and 8, Parahaki Parish, to the Awaroa Creek, and by that creek to Whangarei Harbour; thence by the western side of Whangarei Harbour to the north-eastern boundary of subdivision A, Kopuawaihaha Block, Block V, Ruakaka Survey District; thence southerly along the eastern boundary of the said Subdivision A to a public road, and easterly along that road to the north-eastern corner of Subdivision 4A 3E of the said Kopuawaihaha Block; thence south-easterly along the north-eastern boundary of the said 4A 3E to the south-eastern boundary of the said 4A 3E to the south-eastern corner of the said subdivision; thence south-westerly along the south-eastern boundaries of Subdivisions 4A 3E, 4A 3D, and 4A 3C to a public road, and south-easterly along that road to the south-eastern boundary of Section 100, Mangapai Parish; thence south-westerly along that boundary to a public road, and south-easterly along that road to the south-eastern boundary of Section 83, Mangapai Parish; thence south-westerly along the south-eastern boundaries of Sections 83, 82, and 81 to a public road; thence north-westerly generally along the road forming the western boundary of Sections 81, 76, 75, 74, 73, 72, 71, and 70, Mangapai Parish; thence northerly along the road through Section 116, Ruarangi Parish to the western boundary of that section; thence northerly along the road forming the western boundary of Section 116, Ruarangi Parish, and Section 37, Mangapai Parish, to the southern boundary of Section 17, Mangapai Parish; thence north-westerly generally along the road forming the southern boundary of Section 17 and western boundaries of Sections 16, 15, 13, 14, 20, and 2, Mangapai Parish, Sections 86, 85, 84, 131, and 132, Mangakaramea Parish, and Section 6, Block IV, Tangihua Survey District, to the north-western corner of the last-mentioned section; thence northerly generally along the southern and eastern boundaries of Sections 7, 8, 9, and 10 of the said Block IV to a public road forming the eastern boundary of the last-mentioned section, along that road, and the eastern boundaries generally of Sections 88, 80, and 5A, Maungatapere Parish; thence along the eastern boundary of Lot 6 on deposited plan 13348 to the Te Wai-iti Stream, and along that stream and the north-western boundary of Wai-iti Block to the southernmost corner of Lot 9 on deposited plan 13347; thence along the south-western boundaries of Lots 9 and 7 of said plan 13347 and of Tokitaruna Block, and that boundary produced across the Whangarei Road to the eastern boundary of Waihoanga No. 2, as shown on deposited plan 13587; thence by that boundary to the southern boundary of the Whangarei Water-conservation Reserve; thence by the southern and western boundaries of the aforesaid reserve to the north-eastern corner of Section 49, Kaitara Parish; thence along the north-eastern boundary of the said Section 49 to a public road; thence northerly along that road to Three-mile Bush Road; thence by that road to the western boundary of Hurupaki Block; thence by the western and northern boundaries of Hurupaki Block to the Waikoropupu Stream; thence along the Waikoropupu Stream to the westernmost corner of the Waipiu Block; thence by the north-western and northern boundaries of the Waipiu and Parakiore No. 1 Blocks to Trig. Station 48; thence by a right line to the northernmost point of that part of Parakiore No. 2 Block shown on deposited plan No. 8351; thence by the eastern boundary of that block to the northern boundary of the Kamo Town District; thence by that boundary to the north-western corner of Section 20, Whangarei Parish; thence along the north-western boundary of the said Section 20 to Apotu Road; thence by a right line across Section 88 to the westernmost corner of Section W 84; thence along the north-western boundary of the said Section W 84 to Vinegar Hill Road; thence south-easterly along that road to the north-western boundary of Section 90, Whangarei Parish; thence along the north-western boundaries of Sections 90 and 89 to the northernmost corner of the last-mentioned section, the place of commencement.

7. THAMES DISTRICT.

All that area in the Auckland Land District bounded on the north-west by the Tararu Stream from its mouth to a point opposite the south-eastern corner of Section 4, Block I,

Thames Survey District; thence by a right line to the north-western corner of Section 5, Block V; thence along the eastern boundaries of Sections 1 and 2, Block V, Hape North No. 1 (2599) and Hape North No. 2 (2600) to the south-eastern corner of the last-named block; thence by a right line to the north-western corner of Section 6, Block V; thence along the northern boundaries of that section to the south-west corner of Waokauri; along the southern boundary of that section to the point of contact with the water-race; thence northerly and easterly along that race to the southernmost corner of Section 2716A, where it is bounded by the Kauaeranga River; along that stream in a southerly direction to a point in line with the north-eastern boundary of Te Reu Reu (1731); along that boundary and the southern boundaries of Te Reu Reu (1731), Pakaraka (3734), Kohuroa (2355), and Ngaputaka (1675) to the junction of the latter with Taparahi No. 3; thence along the eastern boundary of Taparahi No. 3 to its south-eastern corner; thence along the southern boundaries of Taparahi No. 3, Tarukinikini (4328), Kohikurere (4546), Huirepo (4536), to the main road; along the main road to its junction with a road leading through Pukehue (6701) and Hurumoimoi (377) to the sea-coast; thence along the last-named road to the coast-line; thence northerly along the coast to the point of commencement.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 10th day of October, 1928.

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in him by section three of the Main Highways Act, 1922, and of all other powers enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby order and declare that as and from the date of this Order in Council the roads or portions of roads and the streets or portions of streets enumerated in the Schedule hereto shall become main highways within the meaning and for the purposes of the Main Highways Act, 1922.

SCHEDULE.

HIGHWAY DISTRICT NO. 1.

Bayley's Coast Road.—All that road or portion of road in the Hobson County commencing at the western boundary of the Borough of Dargaville at the Mangatara Stream at the eastern corner of Section 14, Kaihu No. 1 Block, Block 15, Kaihu Survey District, and proceeding generally in a westerly direction and terminating at the south-western boundary of Kaihu No. 1 Block, Block 13, Kaihu Survey District, being a distance of 6 miles, more or less. Shown on plan P.W.D. 72333, and thereon coloured red.

Also all that street or portion of street in the Dargaville Borough commencing at the junction of Beach Road and Normanby Street, and proceeding generally in a westerly direction via the said Beach Road, and terminating at the western boundary of the Borough of Dargaville at the Mangatara Stream, being a distance of 1 mile 5 chains, more or less. Shown on plan P.W.D. 71163, and thereon coloured blue.

Mititai - Mangonui Bridge (Upper).—All that road or portion of road in the Hobson County commencing at a point opposite the Mititai Wharf in the Village of Newport, Block 5, Toka Toka Survey District, and proceeding generally in an easterly direction, and terminating at the easternmost corner of Allotment E.R. 36, Okahu Parish, Block 3, Toka Toka Survey District, being a distance of 7 miles 24 chains, more or less. Shown on plan P.W.D. 73352, and thereon coloured red.

HIGHWAY DISTRICT NO. 2.

Huntly-Rotongaro.—All that road or portion of road in the Huntly Town District and the Raglan County commencing at the junction of the Great South Road and Raynor Street in the Huntly Town District, and proceeding generally in a north-westerly direction via the said Raynor Street, and thence through Blocks 15, 11, and 10, Rangiriri Survey District, and terminating at a point at the north-eastern corner of Section 12, Block 10, Rangiriri Survey District, being a distance of 6 miles 27 chains, more or less. Shown on plan P.W.D. 71603, and thereon coloured blue.
