RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, and all other authorities and powers (if any) it in that behalf enabling, the Waipawa Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:—
