TN pursuance and in exercise of the powers vested in it in of Lot 78, part Section of all other powers (if any) it thereunto enabling, the Hutt County Council hereby resolves as follows:—

That, for the purpose of providing for the payment of interest, sinking fund, and other charges on the Hutt County Epuni Hamlet Water-supply Loan of £1,700, 1928, authorized
