IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of all other powers in anywise enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby approve of the following resolution passed by the New Plymouth Borough Council on the nineteenth day of November, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-eight, viz. :—

“That the New Plymouth Borough Council, being the local authority having control of the streets hereinafter mentioned, hereby resolves and declares that the provisions of section one hundred and seventeen, subsection one, of the Public Works Act, 1908, shall not apply—

(a) To that portion of the southern side of Vivian Street to which Section 345, New Plymouth, has frontage ; nor

(b) To that portion of the western side of Mt. Edgecumbe Street to which Section 345 has frontage”;

subject to the condition that no building or part of a building shall at any time be erected on the land fronting the southern side of the portion of Vivian Street (described in the Schedule hereto), within a distance of thirty-three feet from the centre-line of the said portion of street.

SCHEDULE.

THE southern side of all that portion of street situated in the Taranaki Land District, Borough of New Plymouth, known as Vivian Street, fronting Section 345, Town of New Plymouth.

Also the western side of all that portion of street in the said land district and borough known as Mt. Edgecumbe Street, fronting Section 345, Town of New Plymouth.
