Good sea-fishing is also obtainable from the rocks adjacent to the Castlepoint Lighthouse. Castlepoint is about forty-four miles from Masterton by good metalled road, and is the best and most accessible seaside resort in the Wairarapa. The sections comprise partly level land and partly sand dunes. They are all suitable sites for seaside cottages.
