NOTICE is hereby given, pursuant to the provisions of the Standing Orders of the General Assembly of New Zealand relating to Private Bills, that application will be made to the General Assembly in Parliament assembled at its next session on behalf of the religious body known as "the Associated Churches of Christ in New Zealand" for leave to introduce a Private Bill to be called "The Associated Churches of Christ Church Property Bill, 1929."
