

Proclaiming a Road-line laid out through Subdivisions of the Hautu No. 3 Block, Wellington Land District, to be a Public Road.

A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS the parcels of land described in the Schedule hereto were, by orders of the Native Land Court made on the sixteenth day of February, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-one, and the fifteenth day of May, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-eight, duly laid off as a road-line, in pursuance of sections forty-eight, forty-nine, and fifty of the Native Land Amendment Act, 1913:

And whereas the said Court is of the opinion that it is in the public interest that the said road-line should be proclaimed as a public road, and a notification to that effect has been forwarded to the Minister of Lands, in terms of section fifty-one of the said Act:

And whereas it is now expedient that the said road-line should be proclaimed as a public road:

Now, therefore, I, General Sir Charles Fergusson, Baronet, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by sections forty-eight, forty-nine, and fifty of the Native Land Amendment Act, 1913, and in so far as each of these sections is applicable, do hereby proclaim as a public road the road-line described in the Schedule hereto.
