WHEREAS by Order in Council dated the tenth day of January, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-seven, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette*, No. 1, of the thirteenth day of the same month, Henry Arthur Purser, of Auckland (who with his executors, administrators, and assigns is hereinafter called "the licensee"), was licensed to use and occupy a part of the foreshore below low-water mark at Little Passage, Coromandel Harbour, as a site for a jetty:

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred by section four of the Public Reserves and Domains Amendment Act, 1925, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby declare that from and after the sixteenth day of February, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-nine, the public domains described in the Schedules hereto shall be united to form one public domain, to be known as the Woodville Domain.
