#### SPECIAL ORDER.

#### WAITOMO COUNTY COUNCIL.

In exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 23 of the Counties Act, 1920, the Waitomo County Council resolves, by

way of special order, as follows:—

1. The present division of the County of Waitomo into 1. The present division of the County of Waitomo into nine ridings is revoked, and in lieu thereof the said county shall be divided into eight ridings, to be called respectively Aria Riding, Awakino Riding, Hangatiki Riding, Mahoenu Riding, Mairoa Riding, Paemako Riding, Tangitu Riding, and Te Kuiti Riding, which said ridings are respectively described in the Schedule hereto.

2. The said Waitomo County Council shall consist of nine members, who shall be elected as follows:—
