And whereas the Rotorua County Council (hereinafter called "the said local authority") has been authorized to borrow the sum of forty thousand pounds:

And whereas the said local authority is desirous of raising the sum of four thousand pounds, being portion of the said loan of forty thousand pounds, on the instalment-repayment system extending over a period of thirty-three and a half wears.

And whereas the Minister of Finance has given his precedent consent as required by section one hundred and fourteen of the said Act to the borrowing by the said local authority of the sum of four thousand pounds, at such rate or rates of interest as shall not produce to the lenders a rate exceeding
