Revoking a Proclamation taking Land for the Purposes of a Native School in Block II, Takapau Survey District.

A PROCLAMATION.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, General Sir Charles Fergusson, Baronet, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby revoke the Proclamation dated the twenty-first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and eighteen, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette*, No. 1, of the ninth day of the following month, taking land for the purposes of a Native School in Block II, Takapau Survey District, such land being no longer required for the purpose for which it was taken.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

to be a Warden to hold and exercise the duties of such office under and subject to the provisions of the said Act during pleasure, on and from the fifteenth day of April, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-nine.
