THE RIGHT HONOURABLE SIR J. G. WARD, PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred on him by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power in anywise enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby amend the Order in Council dated the twenty-first day of December, one thousand nine and twenty-eight, published in the *New Zealand Gazette* on the tenth day of January, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-nine, authorizing the Manunui Town Board to erect electric lines in the Manunui Town District and portion of the Taumarunui County, by revoking clause six of the conditions thereof, and substituting the following clause :—

“The charges for electrical energy shall not exceed 1s. per unit for lighting purposes, and 6d. per unit for motor-power, heating, or cooking purposes; provided that “lighting purposes” shall include the operation of motor-generators for lighting purposes; and provided further, that if the accounts are paid within fourteen days of due date the charges shall not exceed 9d. per unit for lighting purposes and 4½d. per unit for motor-power, cooking, or heating purposes.”

WHEREAS the land described in the Schedule hereto forms part of a reserve duly set apart for quarry purposes:

And whereas it is expedient that the purpose of the reservation over such land shall be changed to a recreation reserve:

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, and in exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon him by subsection one (a) of section seven of the Public Reserves, Domains, and National Parks Act, 1928, doth hereby declare that the purpose of that part of the reserve described in the Schedule hereto is hereby changed from a reserve for quarry purposes to a recreation reserve.
