BOROUGH OF INVERCARGILL.

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

South Area Water and Sewerage Loan of £62,500, 1929.

Passed 10th January, 1929.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Invercargill Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:—

That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of £62,500, authorized to be raised by the Invercargill Borough Council under the above-mentioned Act for the installation of a water-supply and street reticulation of main-pipes, and sewerage installation and reticulation of sewers for the area, now part of the Borough of Invercargill, described in Order in Council dated the 13th December, 1927, Gazette No. 87, including outfall sewer for existing sewerage tanks, as required by the Board of Health by requisition dated 19th November, 1928, made under section 22 of the Health Act, 1920, the said the Invercargill Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of decimal six nine nine (0.699) of one penny in the pound upon the rateable value of all rateable property of the Borough of Invercargill, comprising the whole of the Borough of Invercargill, and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable yearly on the 31st day of July in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty years, or until the loan is fully paid off.
