A PROCLAMATION.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, General Sir Charles Fergusson, Baronet, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the middle line of a further portion of the Waikokopu-Gisborne Section of the Gisborne to Napier Railway shall be that defined and set forth in the Schedule hereto.
